ECS contributes to Imran Khan's fund for flood victims

The cheque was handed over by Muhammad Ilyas, Deputy Chairman ECS, on February 12, 2011 at the former's residence located at Zaman Park, Lahore.

Giving his views after handing over the cheque the Deputy Chairman said that the contribution to Imran Khan's fund was aimed at rehabilitation of the displaced people.
